Dental Clinic Entrance on Broadway

The VMC Dental Clinic exists to improve the quality of life - and the smiles - of our unhoused and low-income Neighbors. We serve uninsured Knox County TN residents over the age of 18 who are defined as homeless per HUD standards (Staying in emergency shelter or a place not meant for habitation) AND Knox County TN residents 18 and older in the HUD income range of extremely low (0-30% AMI), regardless of housing status.

PRIOR TO YOUR VISIT

Unhoused Neighbors will need a completed intake packet prior to visiting the Dental Clinic. You must meet with a staff member through the Bush Family Refuge to complete required paperwork Tuesday - Thursday 9:00 AM - 11:00 AM.

PLEASE BRING TO YOUR VISIT

Low-income/Uninsured Knox County residents need to bring a TN ID with a current Knox County address or copy of lease/utility bill with Knox County address AND a current pay stub, statement from an employer stating wages, Social Security awards letter, or a SNAP letter. Other proof of income may also be accepted.

COST TO PATIENTS

Services are FREE to our patients thanks to our grant and donor partners and the wonderful dental professionals who partner with VMC.

SERVICE HOURS

Our hours and days of service may vary, as our team is made up primarily of volunteer dental professionals.
