PLEASE BRING TO YOUR VISIT:

People who are currently experiencing homelessness will need a completed intake packet prior to visiting the dental clinic.

The paperwork can be completed in the Bush Family Refuge T/W/Th 9:00 AM - 11:00 AM.

Low-income Knox County residents need to bring a TN ID with a Knox County address or copy of lease/utility bill with Knox County address AND a current pay stub, statement from an employer stating wages, Social Security awards letter, or a SNAP letter. Other proof of income may also be accepted.

Our hours and days of service may vary, as our team is made up primarily of volunteer dental professionals.
